

Polychaetes

General information

Varying in size between 8 and 14 cm, polychaetes (sea worms) are an important food source for larger marine predators. They can be cut easily into smaller pieces, making this soft and nutritious food also available for many smaller fish and invertebrates!

After defrosting, it is advised to rinse well with water to avoid unnecessary contamination of the aquarium water.
